## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

**We are a wholesale nursery only. Please do not send your customers to the nursery.** As a precaution to boxwood blight, we limit customer access through the nursery. **For this reason, we do not accept the return of plants once delivered or taken away from the nursery.** If you wish to tour the nursery, please check in at the office upon arrival. Vehicle traffic through the nursery is prohibited.

### **Conditions of Sale:**

- Prices are for the **wholesale trade only** and are subject to change without notice.
- Availability and pricing are updated bi-monthly at **[www.newleaffarms.net](http://www.newleaffarms.net)**.

### **Placement and Pickup of Orders:**

- There is **no minimum** needed for pick-up orders. We encourage you to place orders in advance to avoid delays loading.
- We will only **reserve orders for two weeks** except for seasonal annuals. Requests to reserve plants for more than two weeks in advance will require a **25% non-refundable deposit**.
- Pulled orders must be picked up **within 24 hours** since they are staged in a non-irrigation zone.
- **We ask you and your staff to load your plants and verify all items purchased have been loaded.** *We do not have staff available to assist with loading unless special arrangements are made prior to pick up.* Discrepancies should be noted at time of pick up. If the quality of a plant does not meet your expectations, it should be refused at time of pick up.

### **Order Cancellations:**

- If you need to change the pick-up date or cancel an order, you must do so by phone message or email **before 7:00 am** which is when we start pulling orders.
- Customers who cancel an order after it is pulled will be charged a **20% restocking fee**.

### **Terms of Sale:**

- **Cash, check, or credit card** unless credit terms are approved in advance. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express. There is a **\$35 service charge for all returned checks**.
- **In-house credit accounts are due 30 days from the invoice date.** Customers with overdue Net 30 accounts are subject to an **18% per annum finance charge** plus the costs of collection. **All accounts over 60 days will be converted to a cash only basis.** Finance charges must be paid for an account to be current.

### **Spring Annuals and Fall Pansies:**

- We suggest reserving your annuals early to ensure availability. For large quantities, it is best to order a season in advance so we may plan ahead.
- If you are interested in a plant that we do not currently grow, we are happy to contract grow with advance notice. Please visit our website for a complete list of our current offerings.

**Delivery:**

- Delivery is based on a full truck for your area. We will do our best to accommodate a requested delivery date, however, an exact delivery date may not be possible. New Leaf Farms may adjust the delivery date based on quality of plants and/or delivery constraints. Contact our office for freight rates.
- **ALL CUSTOMERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING HELP UNLOADING ORDERS.**
- **Any damage or shortage should be noted by someone on your staff at the time of delivery. Plants not meeting your expectations should be refused at time of delivery.**
- Please note: a fuel surcharge may be added to your invoice in accordance with fluctuating fuel prices.

**Guarantee:**

- Whether plants are picked up at our nursery or delivered, **no liability for damages** will be assumed after plants are loaded on your vehicle or delivered to your site. ## GRASSES & GRASS LOOK-ALIKES

### ***Acorus gramineus* 'Minimus Aureus' / 'Ogon'**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE

Grassy-Leaved Sweet Flag. Dwarf plant with tufts of narrow, grassy-like leaf blades.

'Minimus Aureus' has yellow foliage getting only 3"-6" tall while 'Ogon' has yellow and green variegated foliage and reaches 6"-12" .

### ***Andropogon gerardii* 'Blackhawks' PP27949**

ZONE: 3                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 4'-5'                      NATIVE

Big Bluestem Grass. This tall, upright grass emerges deep green to dark purple in spring, changing to near black in fall. Purple flowering stems rise in late summer.

### ***Bouteloua gracilis* 'Honeycomb' PP33101**

ZONE: 3                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 30"                      NATIVE

Blue Grama Grass. Drought tolerant, low-growing prairie grass with horizontal tan seed heads above fine-textured narrow leaves which form a dense clump.

### ***Calamagrostis x acutiflora* 'Karl Foerster'**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 5'

Feather Reed Grass. Upright clumps with feathery pink-purple blooms in early summer that turn a rich golden color in fall. A long-blooming, low-maintenance plant with sterile seeds.

### ***Carex dolichostachya* 'Kaga Nishiki'**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE    SIZE: 10"-14"

Sedge. Clump-forming featuring fine-textured, narrow, grass-like, bright green leaves which are edged with yellow. Leaves arch upward and outward in a fountain-like tuft.

### ***Carex oshimensis* 'Evergold'**

ZONE: 6                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE    SIZE: 12"

Variegated Japanese Sedge. Narrow grassy blades have a yellowish-white center stripe bordered by a dark green margin. Arching foliage is great for ornamental planting.

### ***Carex pensylvanica***

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE    SIZE: 8"-10"                      NATIVE

Pennsylvania Sedge. Slow-growing, semi-evergreen plant with soft, delicate, arching, solid green leaves. Tolerant of wet and dry soils.

### ***Festuca x 'Cool as Ice'* PP27651**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE    SIZE: 1'-1.5'

Blue Fescue. Low-growing, semi-evergreen, clump-forming ornamental grass noted for its finely textured, grey-green to steely blue foliage.

### ***Liriope muscari* 'Big Blue' / 'Variegata' \* 10% discount on purchase of 100 or more. \***

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN-SHADE    SIZE: 12"-15"

Lilyturf or Monkey Grass. Groundcover with lavender-purple spike blooms. 'Big Blue' has dark green leaves while 'Variegata' has white to yellow-edged leaves.

### ***Miscanthus sinensis* 'Gracillimus'**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 5'-6'

Maiden Grass. Vase shaped with silver-green leaves/white mid-ribs. Silver fan-like plumes.

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Little Zebra' PP13008**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 3'-4'

Maiden Grass. Nice dwarf form for smaller gardens. Wine-purple blooms in summer fade to tan in fall. Leaves are green with horizontal yellow bands.

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Morning Light'**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 4'-5'

Maiden Grass. Wispy blades of green and white variegation with white plumes in summer.

**Muhlenbergia capillaris**

ZONE: 6                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 3'    NATIVE

Pink Muhly Grass. A showy native grass with fine wiry foliage. Open, airy plumes sit like a pink cloud above the foliage, blooming in fall.

**Muhlenbergia reverchonii UNDAUNTED®**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 1.5'-2'    NATIVE

Ruby Muhly Grass. A compact, cold and heat hardy selection of muhly grass with blooms emerging in late summer and maturing to soft-textured, pink plumes.

**Nasella tenuissima (syn. Stipa tenuissima)**

ZONE: 7                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 18"-24"

Mexican Feather Grass. Narrow green blades form fountain-like clumps. Silvery-green blooms open to downy, feathery blooms in early summer.

**Ophiopogon japonicus**

ZONE: 6                      LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE    SIZE: 6"-8"

Mondo Grass. Evergreen, blue-green foliage with tiny spikes of lilac flowers in summer and bright blue berries in fall. Makes for an easy-growing groundcover.

**Ophiopogon japonicus 'Nana'**

ZONE: 6                      LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE    SIZE: 2"-3"

Dwarf Mondo Grass. A dwarf cultivar of the species - spreads slower. Evergreen.

**Panicum virgatum 'Northwind'**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE    SIZE: 5'x2'    NATIVE

Switch Grass. Dependable, upright habit with beautiful olive-green to blue-green foliage, turning yellow-beige in fall. Tan to yellow panicles in summer.

**Panicum virgatum 'Prairie Dog' PP32736**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE    SIZE: 4'x2'    NATIVE

Switch Grass. Sturdy, upright, blue-green foliage in spring turns to a stunning deep red by early summer. Rosy panicles late summer.

**Panicum virgatum 'Shenandoah'**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE    SIZE: 3'-4'    NATIVE

Switch Grass. A colorful plant, green with red tips darkening in summer to burgundy in the fall. Reddish-pink flowers in summer.

**Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Cassian'**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN    SIZE: 3'

Fountain Grass. Rose-colored plumes and beautiful fall golden color. Drought-tolerant.

**Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Piglet' PP19074**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE                      SIZE: 18"

Fountain Grass. Grows in a graceful, spreading clump with narrow green leaves and showy, bottlebrush plumes. More winter-hardy than 'Little Bunny'.

**Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Red Head'**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN                      SIZE: 3'-4'

Fountain Grass. Rounded, arching green foliage with large smoky-red bottlebrush plumes.

**Pennisetum orientale 'Karley Rose' PP12909**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: SUN                      SIZE: 2'-3'

Fountain Grass. Arching, dark green foliage with smoky rose-purple flower spikes. Longer bloom season and greater cold tolerance than other varieties.

**Schizachyrium scoparium 'Standing Ovation' PP25202**

ZONE: 3                      LIGHT: SUN                      SIZE: 3'-4'                      NATIVE

Little Bluestem Grass. An improved selection with an upright growth habit. Outstanding color variations throughout the year and spectacular fall color.

**Sporobolus heterolepis**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: SUN                      SIZE: 2'-3'                      NATIVE

Prairie Dropseed. Fine arching leaves turn from green in summer to golden orange in the fall. Blooms are a pinkish brown on tall stems in late summer. Decorative seed heads.

**Athyrium filix-femina**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: FULL SHADE-PART SUN                      SIZE: 2'-3'x2'-3'

Lady Fern. Widely adaptable and fast growing. Perfect for wooded gardens or hills.

**Athyrium filix-femina var. angustum 'Lady in Red'**

ZONE: 3                      LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE                      SIZE: 24"                      NATIVE

Lady Fern. Dark green, upright fronds with deep burgundy stems.

**Athyrium niponicum 'Metallicum'**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE                      SIZE: 12"-18"

Japanese Painted Fern. An elegant deciduous fern with silvery-grey, almost metallic fronds and subtle burgundy stems.

**Dryopteris erythrosora Brilliance™**

ZONE: 5                      LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE                      SIZE: 24"

Autumn Fern. New fronds are coppery red to bronze maturing to glossy green. Evergreen.

**Dryopteris filix-mas**

ZONE: 4                      LIGHT: SHADE                      SIZE: 2'-3'                      NATIVE

Male Fern. Compact, semi-evergreen fern with leathery, emerald-green leaves. Clumping habit, non-spreading. Prefers a woodland environment.

**Matteuccia struthiopteris 'The King'**

ZONE: 3                      LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE                      SIZE: 3'-6'                      NATIVE

Ostrich Fern. Green fronds shaped like ostrich plumes turn bronze-gold in fall. Heat tolerant.

**Osmunda cinnamomea**

ZONE 3: LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE SIZE: 2'-3' NATIVE

Cinnamon Fern. Bright lacy upright with cinnamon-colored, spore-bearing fronds in the center. Thrives in wet areas along ponds, streams, and water gardens.

**Polystichum acrostichoides**

ZONE: 3 LIGHT: PART SHADE-SHADE SIZE: 1'-2' NATIVE

Christmas Fern. A great evergreen choice and highly adaptable to almost all soil types, tolerating even deep shade. Thrives almost anywhere east of the Rockies.

**Bignonia capreolata 'Tangerine Beauty'**

ZONE: 6 LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE SIZE: 30' NATIVE

Crossvine. A JC Raulston Arboretum introduction with dark green, semi-evergreen foliage. Summer blooming with tangerine-orange, trumpet-shaped flowers.

**Clematis Happy Jack® Purple PP20343 PW® CC®**

ZONE: 5 LIGHT: PART SUN-SUN SIZE: 6'-8'

Jackman Clematis. Large (3-5") velvety plum-purple flowers with intriguing center highlights and bright yellow stamens. Blooms mid-summer to fall, flowering on new and old wood.

**Clematis x Pink Mink® PP24374 PW®**

ZONE: 4 LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE SIZE: 9-10'

Bright two-toned pink flowers bloom on new wood. Attractive to butterflies and hummingbirds.

**Gelsemium sempervirens 'Margarita'**

ZONE: 6 LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE SIZE: 8-12'

Carolina Jessamine. Semi-evergreen foliage and clear yellow trumpet-shaped flowers. Attractive to pollinators and is deer resistant.

**Hydrangea anomala subsp. peteolaris**

ZONE: 5 LIGHT: SUN SIZE: 15'-25'

Climbing Hydrangea. This vigorous climbing vine is one of the best vines for clinging to brick or stone walls. Lush green foliage with fragrant white lace-cap flowers in June. Deciduous.

**Lonicera sempervirens 'Major Wheeler'**

ZONE: 4 LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE SIZE: 8' NATIVE

Coral Honeysuckle. A hummingbird magnet! Non-invasive vine with red tubular flowers spring through fall.

**Trachelospermum jasminoides**

ZONE: 8 LIGHT: SUN-PART SHADE SIZE: 6'

Confederate Jasmine. Fragrant, star-shaped, white flowers in spring cover a blanket of thick green foliage. An excellent trellised vine.

**Wisteria macrostachya 'Blue Moon'**

ZONE: 4 LIGHT: SUN SIZE: 15' NATIVE

Kentucky Wisteria. Re-blooming vine with grape-like clusters of fragrant lavender-blue



flowers in summer. Long, ovate green leaves on twining stems.
